



FOR 2017/2018 ACADEMIC YEAR

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Truro Treasures Board of Directors, to a second, third, or fourth year student from the Town of Truro who is attending an accredited college or trade school in the United States. Payment of this award will be made directly to the institution being attended by the student.

The award will be based on the student's acceptable academic performance at college or trade school as well as the student's participation in athletic and other extracurricular activities. Prior and possible future community involvement in the Town of Truro will also be a major factor in the awarding of this grant.

It is the sincere hope of the Truro Treasures Board of Directors that this grant may somehow encourage local youths to expand their horizons while remembering and appreciating the quality of life and community that is unique to the Town of Truro.
